PROPERTY UPDATES

Thank you to the FPC congregation for its ongoing support of our ministry to our local community. Our committee recommended to Session an item for action involving the property:

Repairs to the sanctuary roof, including slate tile and copper flashing replacement.

In the 20+ years since a local vendor replaced slate tiles on the sanctuary roof, the property committee discovered missing copper flashing and tiles from the ridge cap earlier this year. There is no longer a local vendor that can complete the scope of work on the high-pitched sanctuary roof. In-state slate tile vendors were contacted and bids were received and reviewed by the committee.

A vendor, the Durable Slate Company, was selected and the committee's recommendation was presented to the Church Trustees, which was approved. The recommended roof action was then presented to Session, which also approved the expenditure for roof repairs. The work is scheduled to begin in December, due to the contractor's backlog of existing contracts.

In addition, local vendor Paullin Sealcoating will be refreshing the Church Street parking lot with new parking bumpers, sealant, and yellow striping of parking spaces. The property committee extends its appreciation and thanks to Matt Paullin for the company's time and materials used in addressing this important visible church space!

The property committee thanks you for your continued support and blessing upon our home of worship.
